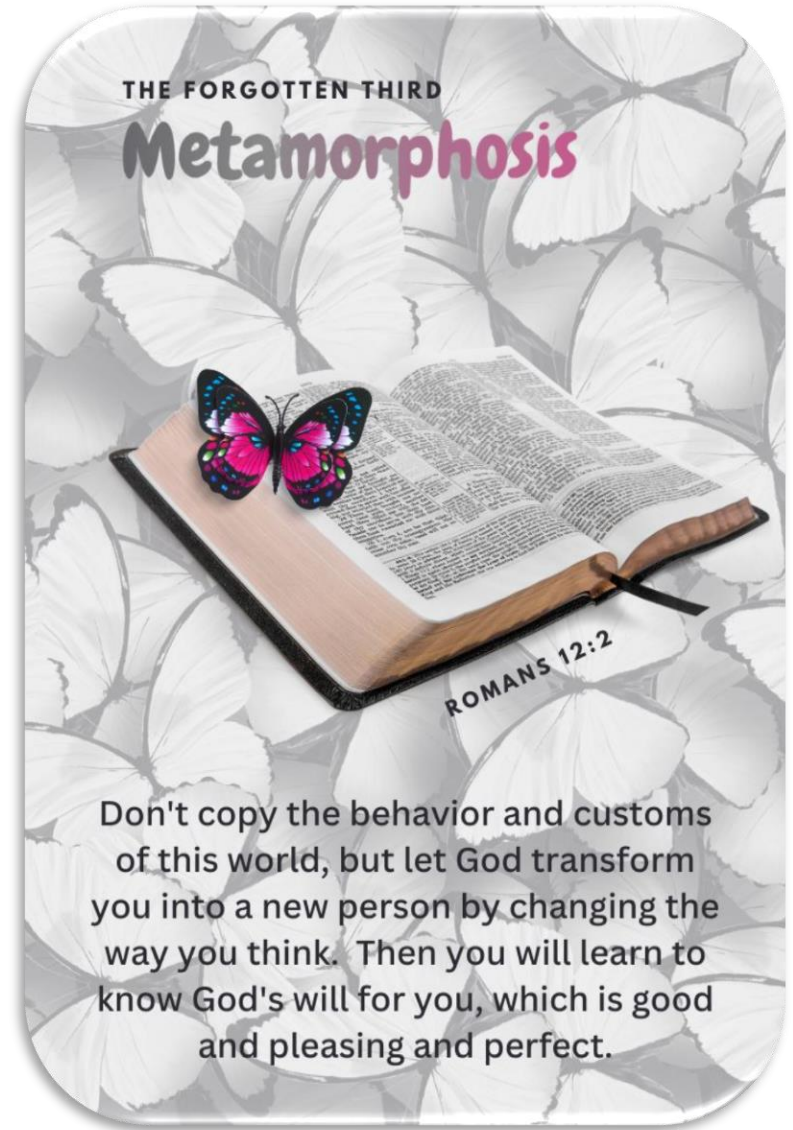

LIFE RECOVERY GROUP Open to anyone recovering from addiction or who have a family member recovering from addiction. Join us Monday nights at 7:00 PM.

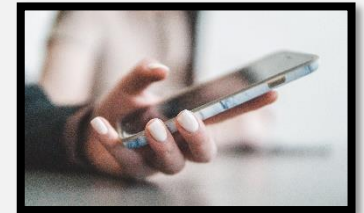
