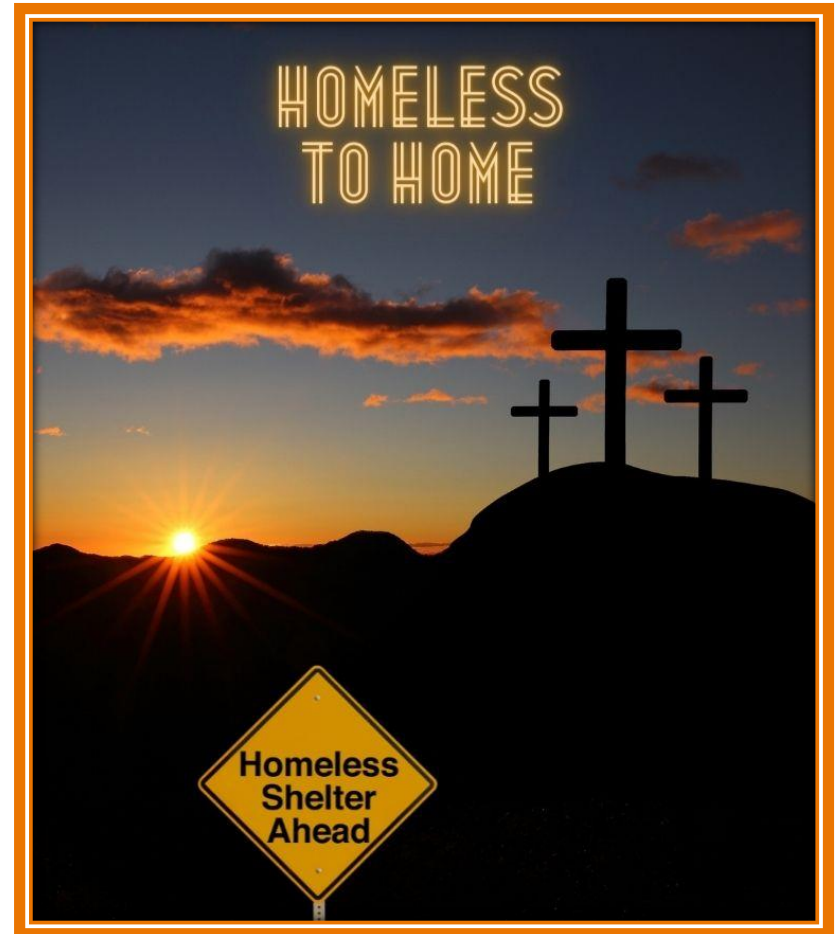

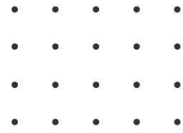


NEW YEARS EVE, DECEMBER 31st
